## AAP I&C 2022 COVID REPORTING PROTOCOLS

To attend the I&C, which is in-person only, you must be fully vaccinated and have at least one booster. Plan to have physical proof of vaccination when you register on-site.

We strongly recommend that everyone bring 2 or more rapid COVID tests to the I&C.

## While at the conference:

Masking will be required in public spaces (lobby, elevators, hallways, bathrooms) as well as in Large Group.

Before the I&C begins, workshop and small process group leaders will anonymously survey group members regarding masking in their group. Please defer to a group member who prefers the whole group to mask; a single member may also find masking themselves suffices. The leaders will also share their contact information with you in case you need to contact them during the conference.

If you feel begin to feel ill, please stay in your room, test, and text or call Diane Shaffer (610.283.0272) with the result. The hotel can deliver meals to your room.

If you test negative but continue to feel ill, please continue to wear a mask at all times and use your best judgment regarding contact with others. Re-test as needed.

If you test positive, please remain in your room and do not interact with others. It will be your decision to remain at the hotel or to return home at this point. If you feel well enough, please reach out to your workshop and process group leaders, as well as any others whom you have been in close contact with to alert them of your positive test. If you need assistance to make these connections, please contact Diane Shaffer.
